AutoCAD is used by the majority of U.S. architectural firms, as a powerful, easy-to-use and accurate drafting and design application. A significant number of architects and designers around the world use AutoCAD on a daily basis. History AutoCAD is an acronym for AUTocad COmputer-Aided DESIGN. The acronym was introduced in 1982 to describe a new idea that was later developed into a computer-aided drawing software application. In 1986, Autodesk was founded as a spin-off from MIT and came into existence by selling the first 32 AutoCAD packages to architectural firms in the U.S. by 10,000 copies. Autodesk sold AutoCAD for a computer platform that was not typically available in an architectural setting, i.e., a computer platform that could be used for both engineering and architectural work. The first version of AutoCAD was published in 1989. Marketing The company held several promotional events such as the famed "AutoCAD Decathlon" which consisted of 10 events including the ability to run a virtual dog race, "AutoCAD Live," to draw an Olympic stadium in 3D. The company also promoted the product by using a fictional character named Charlie Beauchamp, the company's own mascot, to lead events, videos and press conferences. The company also operated a nationwide advertising campaign, "Charlie the CAD Man." Acquisitions Development AutoCAD originally developed on a Windows platform. In 2000, the company migrated to Microsoft Windows and operating systems. By 2004, the entire AutoCAD family was running on the Windows XP platform, including AutoCAD LT, AutoCAD Architecture, AutoCAD Civil 3D, AutoCAD Map 3D, AutoCAD Electrical, and AutoCAD Mechanical. AutoCAD Enterprise was the first AutoCAD product to be developed for Microsoft Windows Vista. It supported Windows Vista and later Windows operating systems. AutoCAD also was ported to the Linux operating system and Apple Macintosh. In August 2009, Autodesk sold off its ownership of Unigraphics, Inc., its developer of VectorWorks, a vector graphics software for CAD applications. Unigraphics was spun off from the company and now operates as a separate, independent business.
